These groups ask that you direct your staff to take the immediate action required under the Act.

Now, five years since promulgation of the 2006 standards, EPA has not even proposed a decision based on a review of these standards. Clean Air Act section 109(d)(1) imposes or EPA a non-discretionary duty to
